"Paint is what you need, Dippy Duck."

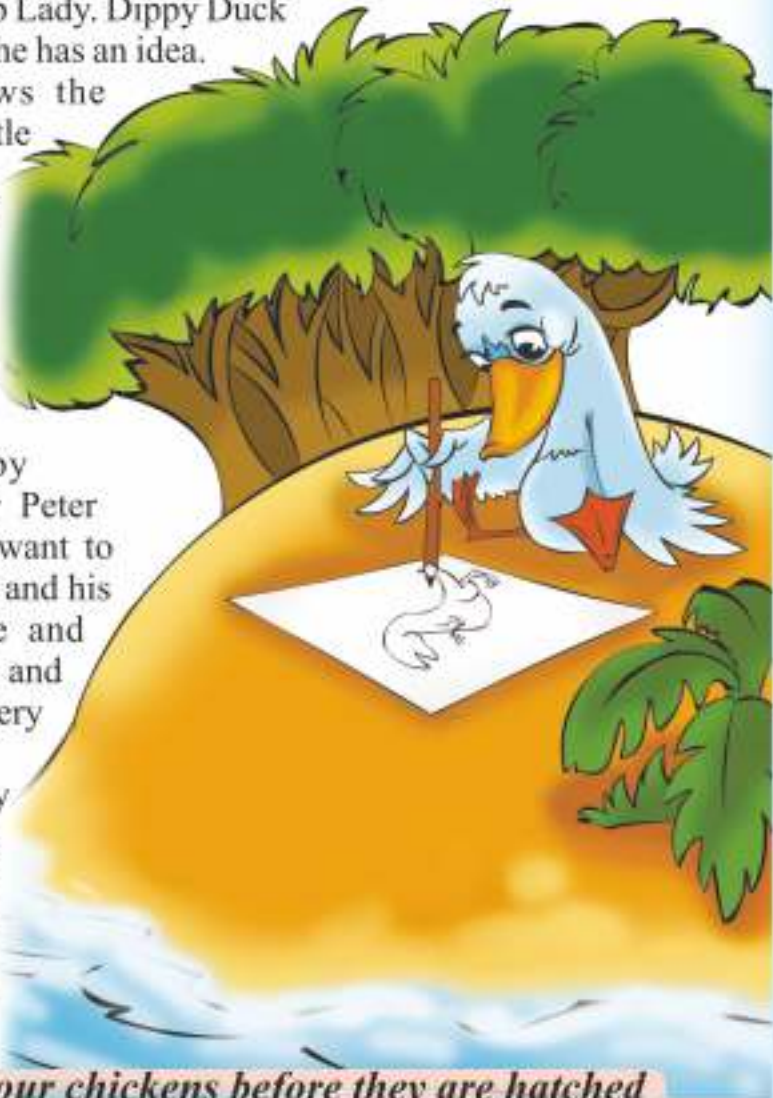
